## SEWER PROJECT UPDATE

With a projected finish date of mid-November, approximately 90% of the sanitary line is now in the ground. Remaining work after the installation of the mainline includes tying in the laterals and then getting to work on restoration items such as drives, seeding and asphalt.

Below are some pictures showing the progress of the project.



### Security:

- Airport gates are currently missing and are in disarray due to the sewer construction. Please help the FBO and Airport Staff keep an eye on the airfield during this period of time. If you see people who do not belong on the airport please ask them to leave or contact the FBO.
- A reminder is being issued to warn people against driving their personal vehicles onto taxiways and aprons. Due to safety and security issues, there are to be **NO** personal vehicles driven onto active aircraft operation areas at *any* time. The County Sheriff will issue traffic violations if the abuse persists.
