

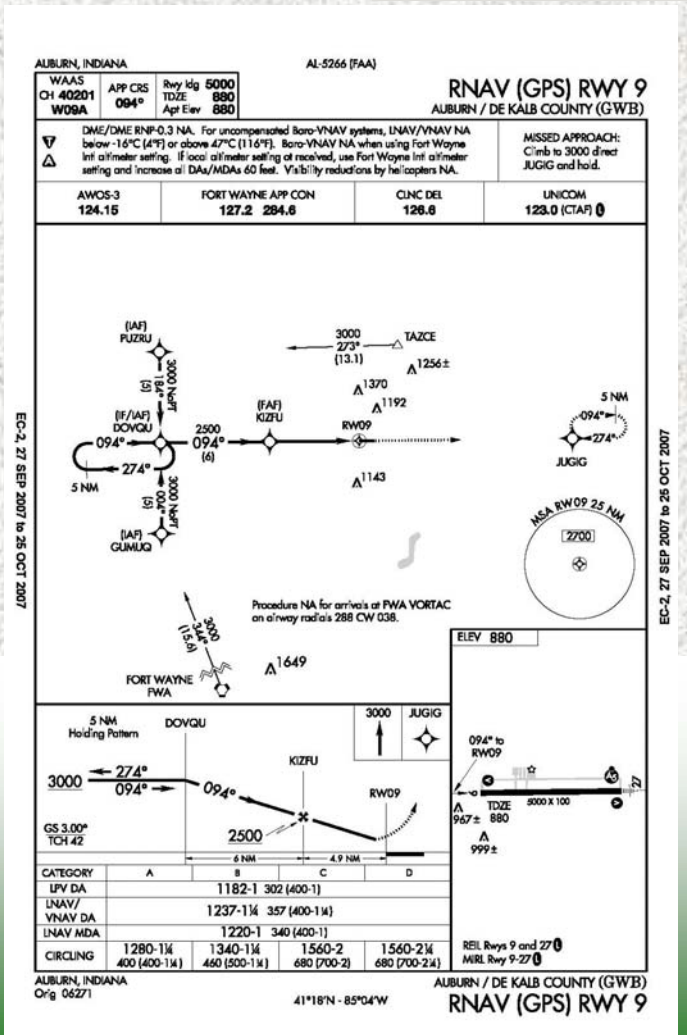
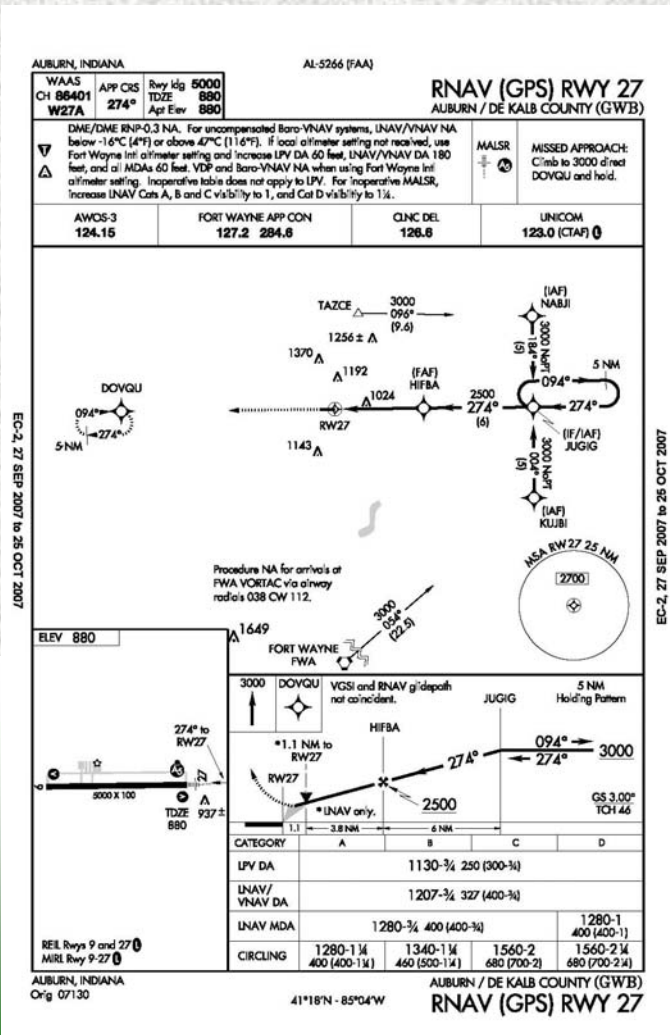

If your aircraft is so equipped, check out the minimums on our newest approaches into GWB for both Runways 09 and 27!!! While the ILS still has the best minimums for Runway 27 at 200-1/2, the lower minimums on Runway 09 will really help when the winds are out of the east and the weather is poor. Ultimately the WAAS minimums for Runway 27 will be identical to the ILS.

DeKalb County Airport is currently the only General Aviation Airport in Indiana with more than one WAAS approach.
